PMI Global Conference 2017 – North America (PMI Global Conference is part of a week-long celebration, bringing together thousands of project and program managers, chapter leaders and business professionals from around the world to share knowledge, strengthen community and lead the evolution of the profession)	varies
SeminarsWorld (face-to-face seminars, held in various cities, vary from one to four days)	varies
Webinars – featured webinars from ProjectManagement.com (earn PDUs quickly and at no cost by attending webinars)	1 hour of webinar = 1 PDU

*PMI Online Courses Learn on your schedule — a	nytime, anywhere	varies
PDUs on ProjectManagement (PMXPO, webinars, webinar PMXPO2017 on 4/27/17 (virgexhibition)	recordings, virtual events) -	varies
*Read (self-directed reading certification that you hold)	that is relevant to the	1 hour of learning = 1 PDU

GIVING BACK	Potential PDU's	Documentation for Audit
Working as a Professional (working in a domain area related to your certification(s))	8 hours max per current certification cycle (can't be transferred)	Proof of employment (job description)
Create Content (authoring books, blogs or articles, create webinars, presentations)	1 hour spent creating content = 1 PDU	Copies of publications, sample education materials or course agendas
Give a presentation (speak at a PMI chapter event, professional conference, or within your organization)	1 hour spent presenting = 1 PDU	Copies of the presentation



	GIVING BACK	Potential PDU's	Documentation for Audit
	Volunteering (non-employer, not-for-profit organizations, PMI Austin chapter, Global PMI)	1 hour of volunteer = 1 PDU	Letter or certificate from org served acknowledging your participation
	Share Knowledge (share your domain knowledge to help others learn and grow, mentoring, teaching)	1 hour spent presenting = 1 PDU	Evidence supporting your coaching/mentoring including notes from and dates of activities
