SECTION A. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

1. Spring 2022 PDD Speaker Focus

All prospective presenters are encouraged to craft a proposal that is innovative and memorable. The presentation should be interactive, unique, and actionable. Case studies, take-home resources, and audio/visual elements are highly encouraged.

2. Style and Format

There will be 2 keynote speakers (opening and closing) and 3 concurrent tracks (3 breakout sessions per track) with 60 minutes per speaker presentation throughout the day. All proposals must be follow the template guideline and word count instructions Section B.

3. Presentation Delivery

PMI Austin will provide selected speakers with the official PowerPoint template for the event. Final speaker presentations should be shared with PMI Austin on or before EOD Friday, April 8. Speaker deliveries and presentation materials will be shared live with virtual attendees and recorded for distribution to conference attendees for 2 weeks after the event.

4. Audience

PMI Austin is the local chapter of the Project Management Institute, Inc., the world's largest association for project managers. The audience includes project managers, portfolio managers, and executives from private and public sectors. About 300 attendees in nearly all industries are expected.

5. Presentation Selection

- Selection Process: Submissions are subject to review by the PMI Austin Professional Development team. If you are selected for an interview, PMI Austin will be in touch by Wednesday, February 9.
- Selection Criteria: relevance to theme and PMI talent triangle, audience testimonials from previous speaking engagements, presenter's professional qualifications, overall presentation quality
- Presenters may not use a conference session for commercial sales pitches, self-promotion, or unwarranted criticism of a competitor. Presentations should only advance the educational process; sales pitches do not and are therefore not acceptable.
 Speakers are not permitted to distribute company promotional literature, brochures, or sales materials in any form to attendees during their session.
- The Program Committee reserves the right to reject or edit any proposal whose content is offensive or defamatory, explicitly unethical or if it contains content that is politically sensitive, supports racism, sexual or religious discrimination, illegal activities, and terrorism.



6. Speaker Benefits

Any cancellation must be no later than EOD Friday, April 15, 2022.
